As part of the system each student has their own Student Portal where they can view their effort scores, badges, effort shares, and other information. Parents, Guardians, and other family members can also view their student's portal by signing on to be a "*Guardian*" of the portal – see number 3 below.

E4Effort scores are updated in real time. To check scores:

- 1. Go to the web address: https://app.e4effort.com or just "app.e4effort.com"
- 2. Choose the "Click Here for Student Access" button.
- 3. Enter the student's access code (received from their teacher); **OR** if the student's teacher or school signed up through Clever use Clever credentials
- 4. If the access code does not work a) make sure that you have not included a space at the front or back of the code, b) check to see if you are using "1's" instead of "l's" or vice versa.
